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About The Links STEAM PROGRAM

PURPOSE

El Paso (TX) Chapter, The Links, Incorporated believes that children of underserved communities matter, and is passionate about actively responding to educational, social and economic oversights in a fun, positive and effective manner. The purpose of this program is to create interest and encourage students, especially those in groups underrepresented amongst STEAM fields, to take science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics courses throughout their curriculum in preparation for post-secondary education in STEAM areas of study. Endorsing larger, more diverse populations of students with experiences in rigorous instruction in STEAM throughout their education will likely result in increased participation in STEAM related career majors. Early engagement of participants in integrated 2nd - 9th grade STEAM based activities which are correlated with their current education would substantially increase the number of youth who eventually recognize the value and reward in studying STEAM. We hope involved students would grow to believe that STEAM related careers are viable and attainable options, and use their experiences to maximize their potential within a competitive 21st century global marketplace.

We also intend to incorporate activities which support mental health awareness within the El Paso community as well as integrate program elements from the other 4 facets within the Links (Arts, Health and Human Services, National Trends and International Trends).

GOALS

The goals of the El Paso (TX) Chapter, The Links, Incorporated STEAM program are:

- A. Establish parent and community partnerships to increase awareness about STEAM education and career opportunities.
- B. Establish partnerships with local, scientific, and higher education communities to provide relevant workplace experiences and mentors for students and parents.
- C. Review, develop, and align programs to ensure STEAM experiences for all students that will provide awareness, exploration, and preparation as appropriate throughout the 2nd -9th grade continuum.
- D. Review, develop, and align experiences for students outside the classroom to ensure awareness and exploration of STEAM experiences.
- E. To help students gain the skills they need to succeed in a world shaped by scientific advances and new technologies.
- F. Increase student commitment to scholastic excellence, for future careers, advanced education, and research in STEAM-related fields.
